## **Travel and Financial Support Information**

If your child will be travelling to school by bus or train, there are several ways in which we can help.

### **Travel by Bus**

Passes for use on Stagecoach buses are available. You simply need to complete the application form and return it to us with a passport photograph – the easiest (and cheapest) way is to take a 'passport style' photograph on your mobile and email it to us. Once the pass has arrived, we will invoice you for the annual cost. You don't have to pay for it all at once though, you can pay: weekly, monthly, all in one go, whichever suits your personal circumstances the best. The full cost of the pass **must** be paid for by the end of July 2026.

For students in years 9-11 the cost of an annual pass is £720.00, which works out at £3.79 per day. Students who live relatively close to the UTC may find it cheaper to purchase a daily/weekly/monthly ticket directly from the coach company.

For our sixth form students, the cost of an annual pass is £820.80. However, North Lincolnshire Council are offering a grant of £362 towards the cost of Post 16 travel. The UTC will also utilise some of its 16-19 discretionary bursary funding to contribute a further £368.80 towards the cost of each ticket. This leaves an overall annual cost to parents of £90 for the year.

Hornsbys use the myTrip App, which allows you to purchase bus tickets for use on their services (please see the Hornsby links on our website for more information).

Unfortunately, we are unable to provide bus passes for students travelling on East Yorkshire or 21 Transport buses.

### **Travel by Train**

Purchasing a season ticket from National Rail can help to reduce the cost of travel to/from the UTC. Please visit their website for more details:

https://www.nationalrail.co.uk/times fares/season-tickets.aspx. Children aged 5 – 15 inclusive receive a 50% discount on most tickets. Once your child turns 16, it may be worth purchasing a 16-17 railcard, as this offers 50% off many services. Alternatively, Transpennine Express offer an education scholar ticket which gives 50% off the price of a pass. To apply you need to email them at <a href="mailto:EducationSeason@tpexpress.co.uk">EducationSeason@tpexpress.co.uk</a> and they will send you the relevant form to complete.

### **Support with Travel Costs**

#### Years 9 - 11

If you are currently in receipt of benefits and/or your child is currently in receipt of free school meals, we may be able to offer some support towards the cost of travel. Please complete and return the 'Application Form to Support Travel Costs', along with copies of any appropriate evidence. All applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis; we may be able to offer up to 50% towards the cost of travel from our hardship and bursary funds.

#### Years 12 & 13

If you live in North Lincolnshire, and more than 3 miles from the Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire, you will be entitled to a travel grant of £120.67 per term (£362 per year), towards the cost of travel. If you apply for a bus pass, the grant will automatically be used towards the cost of the pass; however, if you are travelling by car/scooter etc. the grant will be paid to you to help with your travel expenses.

### Additional Financial Support for Sixth Form Students

#### **Post 16 Bursary**

Additional financial support is available for our sixth form students – please see the 16-19 bursary policy on our website. The full bursary, of up to £1,200, is available for students who are:

- Young people in care
- Care leavers (ESFA class 'care leavers' as young people aged 18-21 who have been looked after for more than 13 weeks or since the age of 14; or young people who cease to be looked after or accommodated)
- Students claiming Income Support or Universal Credit (in their own name)
- Disabled students receiving both Employment Support and Disability Living Allowance or PIP

The 'Eligible to Apply' bursary is available based on the following criteria:

- A household income of below £25,000 (this includes Universal Credit)
- A student currently entitled to Free School Meals
- A student whose parents are currently claiming other means-tested benefits including Income Support, Working Tax Credit/ Child Tax Credit, Income Based Employment and Support Allowance (ESA), who is not entitled to free school meals
- At the decision of the Principal, any student who does not fall under the categories listed above, but consider themselves to be in financial hardship
- Students who are young carers and are not in receipt of a carer's allowance

#### Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Tickets CONDITIONS OF ISSUE

- 1. Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Tickets are issued for the full academic year to students who are attending Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire. These tickets are valid for travel at all times on Stagecoach East Midlands bus services until the expiry date shown.
- 2. (a) Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Tickets are subject to, and must be used only in conformity with the Company's Rules, Regulations and arrangements from time to time in force.
  - (b) The Company will not accept any liability for consequences arising from the discontinuance, whether permanent or otherwise, of the running of any buses. In the event of the permanent withdrawal of a service the Company will refund the value of the unexpired portion of Tickets issued on that service.
  - (c) The Company will not accept liability for consequences arising from alterations in the starting or arrival times of any bus service, for want of accommodation in any bus, for delay in arrival at the destinations or for non-arrival, nor for any delay in the arrival of relief buses or for non-supply of relief buses.
- 3. A photograph must be provided for the Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Ticket before it is issued. An Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Ticket is not transferable. In the event of a breach of this Condition, both the person using it and the person who transferred it will be liable to prosecution.
- 4. Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Tickets must be shown to the driver on each journey and must be produced on demand to any Officer or other servant of the Company. If a ticket is not so shown and produced, the holder thereof shall be deemed not to possess an Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Ticket, and must pay the ordinary fare for the journey in question. No refund of such fare will be made.
- 5. The holder of an Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Ticket is not entitled to priority of place over the other passengers. No seat may be reserved.
- 6. The Company reserves the right to decline to issue or renew an Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Ticket.
- 7. Should an Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Ticket be lost immediate notice must be given to the Company. A duplicate ticket may, at the discretion of the Company, be issued upon payment of the sum of £15.00. Should the original ticket be subsequently found, it must be returned at once to the Company.
- 8. If a ticket be defaced or become illegal, the holder shall return it to the Company, who will issue a new one in exchange at the charge of £15.00.
- 9. The holder of an Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Ticket is not entitled to an allowance in respect of the non-use of the ticket. The Company may, at its discretion, give a refund where certified medical absence of a prolonged period occurs.
- 10. An Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Ticket is liable to forfeiture if there is a breach of any of these conditions.
- 11. The acceptance of an Engineering UTC Northern Lincolnshire Season Ticket will be held to constitute an acceptance of conditions set.
- 12. Students who have reached the age of sixteen and above will be charged the adult fare at all times, with the exception of pupils who are in year 11.
